NYDA IN PARTNERSHIP WITH TRANSPORT EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITY HANDS OVER MOTOBIKES TO KWAZULU-NATAL YOUNG PEOPLE

The National Youth Development Agency (NYDA), in partnership with the Transport Education and Training Authority (TETA), will host the Graduation Ceremony of 68 young people who have successfully completed the Last Mile Delivery Programme in KwaZulu-Natal.

The Last Mile Delivery Programme equips young people with the essential skills and resources needed to enter the growing delivery and digital logistics sector successfully. Through the programme, beneficiaries receive comprehensive business start-up and New Venture Creation training, K53 training with support to obtain both their learner's and motorbike licences, and entrepreneurship development to prepare them for sustainable participation in the economy.

In addition, each participant will be provided with a motorbike, helmet, protective gear, insurance, data vouchers, and working capital, ensuring they are fully prepared for either an employment placement or the launch of their own delivery micro-enterprise.

This important milestone is supported by key delivery industry partners, including Takealot, which continues to play a pivotal role in expanding employment and enterprise opportunities for young people entering the last-mile delivery sector.
