

# What is NYS?

National Youth Service Programme (NYSP) is a government initiative aimed at engaging South African youth in community service activities to strengthen service delivery, promote nation-building, foster social cohesion and to assist youth to acquire occupational skills necessary to access sustainable livelihood opportunities.

The NYDA provides a secretarial function to the National Youth Service, which is the single largest service programme for young people in the country.

# What are NYS objectives?

- · To promote social cohesion and build social capital.
- · To instill a culture of service to communities by young people;
- To inculcate the spirit of patriostism in young people and understanding their role in the promotion of civic awareness and national reconstruction;
- To develop the skills, knowledge and abilities of young people to enable them to make meaningful transition to adulthood;
- · To improve youth employability.

# What are the characteristics of the NYS model?

## 1. Service

Young people get involved in activities and provides various services to their communities which contributes positively and adds value to their learning and personal development. These activities are in line with the national development objectives.

## 2. Learning and development

Learning objectives are set for all participants. All participants are expected to demonstrate a commitment and complete a full year of service in the identified NYS programme.

## 3. Character building and personal development

Youth service programme is designed to develop participant's character and impact leadership skills.

- Service Preparation will prepare participants to be equipped with the necessary skills and tools to be ready to enroll in the programme.
- NYS Aftercare Support: Support services is provided to transition to employment, further education, and business opportunities.



# What are the NYS categories?

The NYS model is implemented through application of the following three categories:

## Category 1

A youth service comprising of a structured model with accredited learning, community service and linkages with exit opportunities as a core criterion. This category targets those that are not in education or employment.

## **Category 2**

This category is mainly voluntary service by young people who are about to complete at Higher Education and Training institutions and require practical experience. This also provides them with an opportunity to give back to their communities.

# **Category 3**

Gap year programme for post matric youth who did not get admission into institutions of Higher Learning and Training to participate in volunteer programmes.

# What is the NYS recruitment process?

The National Youth Service programme is implemented through partnerships with Government Departments, State Owned Entities, Private Companies and Civil Society Organisations. Therefore, recruitment of young people into the NYS Programme takes place through these partnerships. Each NYS project will have a different recruitment criterion in line with the established NYS rules and standards.
